Duties:

- Assist officers with basic crisis intervention, resource referrals and case management consultation
- Extend referral service and follow up to local schools, hospitals and the general public, as needed
- Serve as an advocate in court for victims of crime
- Act as a Police Department liaison to arrange and conduct citizen meetings and training seminars
- Prepare reports and grant applications and conduct special assignments at the direction of the Police Chief or his/her designee

- Bachelor's degree in social work or a related field from an accredited college or university
- Valid driver's license (and insurable through Delhi Township's insurance carrier)
- Ability to work under pressure, maintain confidentiality, make decisions and exercise resourcefulness
