The Board of Zoning Appeals and the Zoning Commission have open positions. The Board of Trustees will review applications and make appointment to fill the open positions. Terms are for five-years. Applicants must be a resident of Delhi Township.

Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA)

The Board of Zoning Appeals meets the first and/or second Tuesdays of the month at 6:00pm. The BZA makes decisions on requests for variances and special zoning certificates, suggests amendments to the Zoning Resolution / Map, and adopts rules on how to conduction of the Board's business.

Duties of Board of Zoning Appeals members are performed collectively as a board. Members maintain working relationships within the Township with the Board of Trustees; Township Administrator; Community Development Director; Zoning Commission; and Law Director.

Zoning Commission (ZC)

The Zoning Commission meets the first and/or third Wednesdays of the month at 6:00pm. The ZC makes recommendations to the Board of Trustees on amendments to the Zoning Resolution / Map, initiates amendments to the Zoning Resolution / Map, makes recommendations on Hillside Development ("HD") District reviews, and adopts rules for the conduction of the Commissions' business.

Duties of Zoning Commission members are performed collectively as a commission. Members maintains working relationships within the Township with the Board of Trustees; Township Administrator; Community Development Director; Board of Zoning Appeals; and Law Director. Maintain working relationships outside the Township with the Hamilton County Regional Planning Commission (HCRPC); Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments (OKI); Hamilton County Engineer; Hamilton County Soil & Water Conservation District; Hamilton County Department of Public Works; Metropolitan Sewer District (MSD); Cincinnati Water Works (CWW); and other agencies as appropriate.

Submit a letter of intent indicating which board you are interested in along with an application to the Community Development Director. Applications will be accepted through December 28, 2018.
